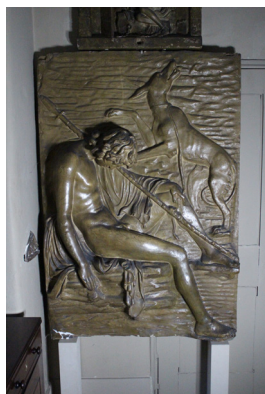

Lower proper right corner of cast is damaged due to stress on the area, most likely due to improper installation. The area will be repaired, however this will just be cosmetic and if the cast is moved in the future, will likely fail.
